American Red Cross

The American Red Cross provides relief to families affected by disasters in West Ellis County. The Red Cross arrives at the scene of local disasters and provides immediate aid to victims. Long-term needs for victims can also be provided when applicable.

Bridges Training Foundation

Bridges Training Foundation serves people with intellectual and developmental disabilities from all over the Dallas/Fort Worth area through advocacy services, support groups, and education programs designed to make communities aware of the unique challenges people with disabilities face.

Common Ground Ministries

Common Ground Ministries is a Christian outreach to children and youth in east Waxahachie, Texas. Their mission is to provide a safe and structured environment for children and youth to meet their spiritual, educational and physical needs. Common Ground Ministries also hosts a program for youth after school, during Spring Break and the duration of the Summer.

Ellis County 4 H

A unique education agency, the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service teaches Texans wherever they live, extending research-based knowledge to benefit their families and communities. The mission of 4-H is to offer its members the opportunity to grow intellectually and develop life skills through a wide array of programs so that they develop into productive and contributing members of society.

Ellis County Children's Advocacy

Ellis County Children's Advocacy Center provides a child-friendly environment that facilitates a coordinated intervention process reducing further trauma to the child. Their goal is to optimize the investigative and prosecution process, provide quality legal, psychological, social and medical services to abused children and to heighten community awareness.

Ellis County Homeless Coalition

The Ellis County Homeless Coalition is a community action group of concerned citizens and organizations dedicated to raising awareness, preventing homelessness and developing affordable housing in Ellis County. They exist to spearhead the fight against homelessness in Ellis County. They have made it their mission to come alongside other non-profits in the county to equip citizens with the tools they need to break the cycle of poverty and set them up for a better tomorrow.

Harvest Family Life Ministries

Harvest Family Life Ministries exists to defend, care for, and support abused, abandoned, and neglected children in our community, state, and nation. They do this in our own local community through various programs and by engaging, equipping, and empowering local churches to do the same. Their Vision is to see the US orphan crisis eradicated one community, one church, and one child at a time.

Manna House

Manna House is dedicated to serving the physical, emotional and spiritual well being of people in crisis, striving to bring hope, encouragement and stability as they build a stronger & healthier community. Manna offers a food pantry and other needs such as clothing. All funds made by Heaven's Attic Thrift Store are directed back to Manna House and to the community.

Meals on Wheels of North Central Texas

Meals on Wheels of North Central Texas provides daily meals for the homebound elderly and disabled residents across north central Texas. They not only provide a warm, nutritional meal but also conduct well checks on the individuals to ensure their needs are being met and they are living in a safe environment.

Mentor's Care

Mentors Care reaches high school students at risk for not graduating due to unfortunate circumstances in their home or school life. Mentors Care pairs community volunteers with students to increase their likelihood for graduation and also create a plan for after high school.

Midlothian Senior Activity Center

The Midlothian Senior center provides a positive, caring environment for local residents. They offer a wide range of classes, educational seminars, health screenings, flu shots, foot care, musical performances, field trips to local venues, transportation services to and from the center and local doctors, the hairdresser and stores. Free hot lunches are served daily and there is also a weekly food pantry. Senior Citizens consider the Center a home away from home.

Next Generation Education STEM Garden

The Next Generation Education STEM Garden provides an innovative program for students and Senior citizens with a positive, fun learning environment that fosters an appreciation for our natural environment and increases their STEM knowledge.

Paws for Reflection Ranch

At Paws for Reflection Ranch, professional therapists will help you design a counseling program that is right for you and/or your child. Working alongside equine professionals and our animal team, sessions will be structured to help you reach your goals, to assist you on your way to optimal mental health.

Presbyterian Children's Homes and Services

PCHAS provides Christ-centered care and support to children and families in need. By doing this, they improve the self-sufficiency of families and their mental health, while reducing child abuse and neglect in the community. This improves the health and prosperity of the Waxahachie area community.

Salvation Army Red Shield Youth Center

The Salvation Army Red Shield Youth Center of Waxahachie provides an after school enrichment program during the regular school year and a day camp over the summer. Children have the opportunity to fill idle time with education, exercise and extracurricular activities. Staff and after school care workers are utilized as role models and provide an array of programs for youth 6-18.

Sisters in Spirit of Texas

Sisters in Spirit of Texas serves widows seeking to navigate through the experience of spousal loss and gain understanding, healing and growth through the grief process. Our desire to empower our widows' emotional, social, spiritual, and physical health directs our goal to encourage awareness of financial security, overall health and education.

The Anchor Home

The Anchor Home seeks to meet the physical, emotional and spiritual needs of women in need and widows in Ellis County. Through emergency housing, support groups, financial literacy and spiritual support, we help women look toward a brighter tomorrow.

The Heights of Ellis County Family Resources

The Heights of Ellis County helps save the lives of women and children in Ellis County from the crime of domestic abuse. They are a public safety organization that uses science based assessment tools to determine a victim's risk of homicide. They also provide mental and physical health resources to their clients as well as job educations and other education programs to help their clients get back on their feet to a fully sustained life.

Unite Ellis

Through a holistic and relational infrastructure, Unite Ellis seeks to inform, connect, and equip Ellis County partners to care for their people and communities, empowering them to maximize collaborative efforts. They coordinate care throughout Ellis County, across all sectors and various social issues. Through streamlined communication and network teams, they are able to connect individuals and families in need to people and organizations who can meet that need.

Waxahachie Care Services

Waxahachie Care provides counseling/ referrals, food, toiletries and financial assistance. Counseling with clients is designed to ensure an effective delivery of assistance. Food is provided through the in house food pantry service. Financial assistance based on availability, is primarily to help with utilities, rent, gas, elderly needs and transportation needs.

Waxahachie Senior Citizens Center

The Waxahachie Senior Center provides a social outlet for Seniors age 50 and over. The center serves lunch daily and hosts a variety of activities, including games, cards, fitness classes, exercise equipment, sewing, dancing, computer classes, dancing, ceramics and much more.
