

Populations at Risk of Being Undercounted

SINGLE PARENT HOUSEHOLD

- 10% of the county's households are single-parent households
- Estimate of 5,777 households

NUMBER OF YOUNG CHILDREN

- 7% of the county's population are children under 5.
- Estimate of 10,963 people

ETHIC MINORITIES

- 26% of the county's population is Hispanic (regardless of race)
- 11% of the county's population reported their race as Black (either alone or in combination with other races)
- 1% of the county's population reported their race as Asian (either alone or in combination with other races)
- 3% of the county's population reported their race as American Indian or Alaska Native (either alone or in combination with other races)

RENTER HOUSEHOLDS

- 27% of the county's households are renter occupied
- Estimate of 15,080 households

IMMIGRANTS

- 9% of the county's population was born outside the U.S.
- Estimate of14,439 people

LOW-INCOME POPULATIONS

- 9% of the county's population is in poverty
- Estimate of 15,481 people have incomes below the poverty level
- Another 16% of the population is near poverty
- Estimate of 26,664 people have incomes between 100 and 200% of the poverty level

NONE OR LIMITED INTERNET ACCESS PERCENTAGE: 14.42%


CELL INTERNET ACCESS ONLY PERCENTAGE: 12.43%

OBJECTIVE:

The 2020 Census will shape Texas' future for the next decade. For a state as large and diverse as Texas, it's key that we actively work to make sure Ellis County counts all our residents — especially in hard-to-count communities.

ESTIMATES

Based on the latest census estimates (for the 2014-2018 period), 167,075 people live in 55,840 households in this county, and 1,763 people live in group quarters. (Total population = 168,838.)

The Census Bureau will invite households across Ellis County to participate in the 2020 Census by:

- Mailing a letter to 97.4% of the county's housing units, beginning March 2020.
- Hand-delivering a census packet to 2.6% of the county's housing units, beginning March 2020.

The self-response rate for Ellis County in 2010 was 79.20%.
